Attendance Policy

- Students in grades 9-12 who have accumulated more than five (5) unexcused absences, may not receive credit for that class.
- Every absence will require an independent excuse.

Required Courses for Graduation

- Math - 4 credits: Algebra, Geometry, & Adv Algebra are required
- Science - 4 credits: Biology & Physical Science are required
- Lit - 4 credits: Ninth Gr Lit & American Lit are required
- History - 4 credits: American Gov, World History, US History, and Econ are required
- Pathway - 3 credits: 3 courses in one area
- Personal Fitness & Health - 1 credit

TOTAL CREDITS REQUIRED: 24 Credits

12th Grade Math Options

Senior math courses offered at CHS

- **Adv. Financial Algebra**
- **College Readiness Math**

Both are HOPE Rigor courses and will be accepted at colleges and universities

Honor and Superior Honor Graduates

- **Honor Graduates**

- 90 or better cumulative average

- **Superior Honor Graduates**

- 95 or better cumulative average
- Advanced Academic Pathway
 - **Requirements**
 - Earn four credits in one academic subject area
 - One of those credits must be an AP course or an academic DE course
 - Plus two credits of Foreign Language

Differences in GPAs

- HOPE GPA is calculated by using **Core Academics** plus **Foreign Language**
 - Math, Science, Social Studies, English and Foreign Language
 - Electives **DO NOT** count
 - CTAE course that count as a science credit **is calculated into your HOPE GPA**
 - Any **extra points** that are added by the school AP(5), De(4)Honors(3) **are deducted (.5 added back for DE & AP)**
 - **See your HOPE GPA through your GAFutures account**
- High School GPA is calculated using all types of credits
 - Math, Science, Social Studies, English and Foreign Language
 - Electives **DO** count

- Must take a minimum of 4 Rigor courses to be HOPE eligible in the following types of courses:
 - Advanced Math courses
 - Advanced Science courses
 - AP courses in core areas
 - Dual Enrollment Courses
 - Advanced foreign language courses

HOPE/Honors & AP Classes

- Honors, DE and AP Classes receive additional points towards your High School Core GPA
- Please remember that HOPE does NOT honor those points. However, for AP and DE courses GSFC will add a 0.5 to the grade...up to a 4.0
- Once these points are removed it **CAN** keep you from receiving HOPE

College Applications Process

- Submit applications.
 - All colleges have different deadlines
 - Request an unofficial transcript
 - May need a Letter of Recommendation
 - Must fill out a Senior Brag Google Form a week in advance prior to deadline
- Check your college's requirements for SAT/ACT test scores.
- Immunizations
 - Required form
 - May have to get shots
- Proof of Residence
 - Driver's license
 - Student ID
- Send a final official high school transcript.
 - After graduation
 - Must let Mrs. Braye know where to send it

FAFSA

- Free Application for Student Financial Aid can be submitted the 1st of October
- This is the application for HOPE and any other state or federal assistance
- 2022 tax refunds
- Students and Parents need to create an FSA ID at <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/>

Local Scholarships

- **Requirements**

- Scholarship Application
 - Can be found on the website under Guidance and then forms
- College letter of Acceptance
- Two community letters of recommendation
- Two teacher letters of recommendation
- Transcript w/ SAT or ACT scores

- **Additional Requirements**

- Complete a FAFSA
- SAT/ACT scores must be on the transcript
- GPA of 80

Applications are pushed out at the end of Jan.

Graduation Letter of Intent

- Students who are at risk for not completing all required course by graduation will be identified at the beginning of 2nd semester.
- These students and parents will have to sign a Graduation Letter of Intent.
- You will receive these from your **advisement** teacher
- It states that:
 - All required credits must be earned before graduation
 - * If all requirements for graduation are not complete, you will **NOT** be allowed to walk in the graduation ceremony.

Service Hours

- It is your responsibility to submit these hours.

- You must have 120 hours to receive a cord at graduation.
