# What to **KNOW**

**SCHOOL DAY** The school day begins at 8:00am. Students begin entering the classroom at 7:45, at which time they begin their morning work. # What to **KNOW** **BEHAVIOR**

We will use Class Dojo this year for our discipline plan. **Please see the Class Dojo form for instructions on how to connect to our class.** Each student will begin the week with 6 green (positive) points. When a student receives a red dojo, one will be deducted from their green points.

Consequences for red points:

1 – 2 red points - warning

3 red points - silent snack beginning on the day 3 red points are received through Friday

4 red points – silent lunch beginning on the day 4 red points are received through Friday

5 red points – no Fun Time Friday – \*\*Parents contact

6 red points – Documented Office Referral (3 documented office referrals = office write up)

\*\*Parent contact will be your class dojo report you view on your phone or computer. Please check your child's points daily so you will know if he/she receives 5 red dojos.

Students will be rewarded with Fun Time Friday for having at least 2 green dojos at the end of the week.

We believe that Class Dojo promotes positive behavior, better attention and responsibility, and more successful students. Please let us know if you have any questions, concerns, or comments regarding our behavior system.
