What is the National Junior Beta Club?

- National Organization
- 2 Junior Beta Divisions
- 1. Junior Beta Division 1 Elementary 4th and 5th grade
- 2. Junior Beta Division $2 6^{th} 8^{th}$ grade (Students must requalify in 6^{th} grade) *6th graders being inducted this year will start participating in 7th grade
- 3. Focused on four area (pillars): Character, Leadership, Achievement, and Service

BSMS Junior Beta Vision

Vision:

The BSMS Junior Beta Club will be a positive environment where students can build leadership and character through service to our community.

The Requirements for Induction

- 3.85 GPA (after 1st semester in 6th and 7th grade) Includes all classes (academic and connections)
- No discipline referrals
- Induction fee (includes membership certificate, membership ID number, and pin) \$35 one time fee
- Attend Spring Induction (TBD)

Membership Responsibilities

- Maintain a 3.85 GPA and a clean discipline record
- Sign membership contract (once per year and will be given out at the first meeting)
- Attend monthly meetings
- □ Usually the second Tuesday of the month from *4-5 pm in your grade level sponsor's room.
- ☐ If you cannot attend a meeting, you must
- 1. Provide an excuse to your grade level sponsor
- 2. Complete an additional service hour for each missed meeting.
 - Complete 10 hours of qualifying service for each term (Summer, 1st, 2nd and 3rd)

Service Hour Requirements

- 10 service hours per nine weeks (Summer, 1st, 2nd 3rd)
- No more than 3 hours from donations
- No more than 3 hours from family events
- No limit to community hours
- Due last Friday of each 9 weeks period before break. Anything turned in after is considered late. Any events planned over breaks should count towards the next nine weeks period

Examples of Service Hours

- Beta Hours official Beta Club events (Clean the Campus, Operation Christmas, Spaghetti Dinner, etc). We discuss these at monthly meetings and send Remind messages for upcoming events
- Donation Hours donations of goods to charitable causes \$7 worth of goods = 1 hour;
 Examples include BSMS food pantry, Operation Christmas, etc.
- **Family Hours** helping family members (NOT including chores and NOT paid)
- **Church Hours** assisting with church functions (NOT paid)
- **Community Hours** any other community projects that do not fall into the other categories (food bank, soup kitchen, animal shelter, helping neighbors, etc)

*note: if an activity is REQUIRED by another organization, it is not volunteer work.

Probation

Members may be placed on probation for the following reasons:

Not attending monthly meetings (Students can miss 3)

Failing to turn in service hours

Failure to turn in correct hours with signatures

Loss of required GPA

- Probation is a warning
- If you meet all expectations the following nine weeks, you will be returned to full membership

Removal

Members may be removed for the following reasons:

Discipline Referral (Automatic Dismissal)

Probation status <u>TWO</u> 9 weeks in a row (Ex. Failure to turn in service hours, not meeting the GPA requirement, etc.)

Officers

Current Jr. Beta members can run for a leadership position

President: Lead meetings, Speaks at induction

Vice President: Supports the President's duties/responsibilities

Secretary: Takes roll and minutes during meetings

- Students can create posters asking students to vote for them and we will hold the election at our second meeting in September
- Students running for office will spend a few minutes before voting to encourage their peers to vote for them
