Support Your Child's Learning: Drop Off by 7:50 and Pick Up at 2:55

- **4** Early pickups at the end of the school day result in valuable lost learning time for your child—and cause disruption to the teacher and the learning of all other students in the classroom. It is important that students attend a full day of school from 7:50 am to 2:55 pm.
- **Early pick up for any reason other than a doctor's appointment requires meeting with** the principal at the time of pick up.
- If you come early and have not called in advance to let us know of a scheduled doctor's appointment, you will be asked to return to your car to wait.
- Fridays are typically full days of school—please respect that and avoid picking up early to get a head start on the weekend.
- Trying to avoid the carline is not an acceptable reason for picking up early.
