

Policy of the Board of Trustees

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STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES

North Country Charter Academy will contract with a school nurse from a supporting district. The school nurse will complete the required state health reports.

In the absence of a school nurse, the Principal is responsible to administer the health program.

Treatment is limited to first aid care. The Center Director or Teacher will attempt to notify parents before a student who is ill is permitted to go home.

- A. Any student not in class because of illness will be followed up with a phone call and monitored by the Teacher or Center Director. Information will be pertaining to absence will be included in student log.
- B. All student medications must be taken before or after the students 3 hour scheduled time with NCCA. No medication is to be administered by school person, except as prescribed by a doctor and accompanied by a parental permission form and cannot be taken before or after the students scheduled session.
- C. All accidents occurring on school property are to be reported to the Center Director and the Principal immediately.
