

Week of: November 6th – 10th

Theme: Pumpkins

This week will consist of the theme focused on pumpkins. We will be focusing on the letter: I and number: 9 this week. We will continue to learn about the life cycle of a pumpkin, parts of a pumpkin, the resources needed to grow a pumpkin, and the difference between a living and nonliving pumpkin. We will read pumpkin themed books. We will have whole group and small groups. Music and movement will consist of singing and dancing to theme related songs. We will attend music class on Wednesday! For science, we will weigh and measure pumpkins and create a pumpkin volcano. We will have a fun letter I themed activity! Using pumpkins and Candy Corn, we will work on the following math skills: counting, quantifying, sorting, patterns, number identification, and graphing.
