Frequently asked questions for the beginning of the year:



Does my child have homework?

 This year your child will have a <u>Responsibility folde</u>r to bring back to school each day. If there are papers on the <u>Return</u> side, they will be required to come back to school. Spelling words to practice for the week will be sent home on Fridays. <u>Please spend 20 minutes each</u> day reading with your child.

Classwork questions:

• Each year I get questions about classwork completion. As you look at your student's work you will sometimes see that it is incomplete. During class we don't always have time to finish everything. If you would like your child to finish the work at home for practice that is great but they do not have to. If there is a required piece of homework, I will write "homework" in a bright color at the top. Please have them finish those pages at home and return them to school.

What is the library routine?

 Each week we have library time. Please have your child bring their books back each week to check out new books. If you're not finished with the book you are welcome to keep it another week and return it the next. Your child child can only have two books checked out at one time.

What if our after school plans change?

 If your child's after school plan is different from what they usually do, you must notify the school. Your student will then get a yellow note which lets staff know that they are to do something different. If we do not receive notification, your child will follow the after school plan listed on their registration.
