

## Parents,

Jackson County Central Schools sports medicine would like to do an assessment of your child's balance, reaction time, and memory functions so that in the event your child sustains a suspected head injury in the future, we can compare the scores from that incident to the scores from their baseline assessment. This information is used in the evaluation and management of head injuries to help in the return to learn and return to play process. This was previously accomplished through use of the ImPACT test, but will now be done using SWAY Medical.

There is no pass or fail on this baseline assessment and your child's scores are not compared to any other athlete's scores. To perform this test, we are asking that your child be allowed to download a free app from SWAY Medical to their phone or tablet. They will be given a temporary code on the day of testing to allow access to the app's testing functions. At the conclusion of the baseline assessment, the app may be deleted.
