
Everyday attendance is expected with our program. Take a look at the programming information to ensure the program dates work with your family's schedule.

Attendance Expectations and Procedures

Attendance is expected everyday of a program. If a student enrolls in a program and doesn't show up for programming or a student misses more than 3 days of programming, the school will make efforts to contact the family. If contact is unsuccessful, the school will open the spot for a student on the waiting list to attend.

Transportation Information

After School Pick Up

Students are to be picked up at the front of the school no later than 4:30. Failure to pick up students on time more than three times will result in that student being dismissed from the after school program, and the school will open the spot for a student on the waiting list.

After School Bus Routes
