Parents and students do have the right to register complaints regarding IB programme-related decisions taken by the school. The steps are:

- 1) Fill in the IB PYP Complaint form.
- 2) Email this form to the student's teacher and the IB Coordinator within the academic quarter.
- 3) Upon careful review, the teacher and IB coordinator will discuss the complaint and share the results with the parent and students.
- 4) The complaint form will be filed in the office for future reference.
