6th Grade and New Student Orientation Details:

Welcome class of 2032 to the Shippensburg Middle School! We are excited to meet each of you and be a part of your education journey. Orientation will take place on August 14th at 10:00 a.m.; 2:00 p.m. OR 5:00 p.m. Please choose the time that works best for your family. **No sign up is necessary**. During this time you will receive an overview of the middle school, receive your team information, meet building administration and office staff, and complete a self guided tour of the building. Orientation will take approximately 45 minutes. Locks will be available for purchase during this time. Locks will be \$3.00 each. All Chromebooks will be distributed the first week of school.

Changes for the Upcoming School Year:

As with everything in life changes are inevitable. Below are key changes for this coming school year.

- Grading scale has been adjusted to be compatible with the high school to a 10 point scale. An A will be 90-100%; B 80-89%; C 70-79%; D60-69% Failing 59% and below.
- The minimum grade a student can earn in Marking Periods 1 3 is a 50%.
- Chromebooks will stay at school full time. Loaner Chromebooks will available to be checked out from the Media Center.
- A new Exploratory has been added to the rotation:
 Design and Discovery. This exploratory will replace
 Health in the five exploratory cycle rotation.
- Health will join Fitness rotation. Students will have health for 1/3 of the school year and Fitness for 2/3 of the school year every other day.
- STEAM has been replaced with a new exploratory CreaTech.
- Backpacks will not be carried throughout the school day. 8th graders will be returning to their homerooms daily at the end of the day to gather their belongings prior to dismissal.
- Student drop off arrival and dismissal procedures will be changed this year due to the new traffic pattern.
 Additional information will be forthcoming prior to school starting.
