### Organizational Structure and Effectiveness

Recommendation: Create Special Education Policies and Procedures Manual.

- The manual will assist the school personnel in understanding and implementing Federal, State and the Districts policies to serve students with disabilities.
- The manual will communicate the districts policies, procedures and operational practices for the Special Education program.

### Organizational Structure and Effectiveness cont.

Recommendation: Increase Communication with Special Education Department Staff:

- Inform special education staff of training and professional development opportunities.
- Schedule regular, mandatory staff meetings and communicate any new regulations, district policies bi-monthly.

## Special Education Revenues and Expenditures

Recommendation: Develop a formal and collaborative budget planning process with focused topics and measurable goals.

- Review Non-Public agencies services to determine if continuance is most effective approach to meet the districts needs.
- Review and evaluate expenditures related to state/federal grants,
  SBCSELPA Mental Health, and regional programs.
- Review and evaluate staff position control.
- Adopt a district transportation policy for students with disabilities.

#### **Special Education Cost Drivers**

Recommendation: Review and evaluate the districts intervention support system, and continuum of services, operating cost.

- Implement an MTSS intervention support program with fidelity.
- Train staff to consistently implement an Student Study Team process and measure the results.
- Develop a broader continuum of placement options, including further opportunities for co-teaching, inclusive models, and district programs.

## Analysis of Special Education Staffing

Recommendation: Implement strategies to recruit, hire, and retain staff including related services, special education, and substitute staff.

- Hire sufficient staff to provide services and deliver quality instruction to students
- Consider increasing the hours of paraprofessionals to support students full time to provide instructional and behavioral support, planning, collaboration time and professional development opportunities.

## Individual Education Plan - Compliance

Recommendation: Develop a process to periodically review completed IEPs for compliance and accuracy across the programs.

- Review existing best practices for development of compliant IEPs and train staff on implementing the protocols.
- Conduct reviews of IEP files before they are finalized and filed.
- Utilize the functionality of the SIRAS system to monitor IEP compliance components by site and Department administrators.
