Grade 8 –School Supplies

Now that DMS is a one-to-one school, it is assumed that some notes and classwork will be done and saved electronically to a subject-specific folder either on the student's personal laptop or Google Drive. If a student prefers to use pen and paper it is necessary to have at least one binder with one section and filler paper for each subject.

Additional General Supplies

- Assignment Pad (supplied by school)
- Blue and Black Pens
- Pencils (no. 2)
- Erasers
- Headphones/Earbuds (mandatory)
- Folders for all subjects (suggested: accordion folder or a [multi-subject folder](#))

Additional Requirements by Subject Matter

Language Arts

- One 1 ½ or 2 inch, three-ring binder
- Two packs of 8-tab binder dividers (w/ pockets preferred)
- Three packs of college ruled loose leaf paper (w/ reinforced edge preferred)
- Tot stapler (small personal size) with staples for pencil case
- 2-3 packages of small post-it squares
- 2-3 highlighters

Math

- Heavy duty 1" binder
- Four or five one-subject notebooks (one notebook per marking period) to be placed in the 1" binder
- Correcting pens
- TI-84 Plus CE (Intro to Algebra-optional / Algebra-mandatory)



Social Studies

- Composition notebook for notes and warm ups

Science

- One single-subject notebook for notes and do-nows

Art

- 1 Smock (This is a requirement) in a large Ziploc bag with your name on it. Smocks should be big enough to easily fit over a student's clothing.
- 1 nylon knee-high stocking (to be used for a sculpture project)

Health

- 1 2-pocket folder
- 1 inch binder
- 1 pack of 3 hole punched loose leaf paper
- 3 tab binder dividers

Spanish

1 plastic folder with pockets and prongs

Line paper

Colored pencils, two highlighters (each a different color) and dry erase markers
