GUIDELINES FOR EARLY DISMISSAL & LATE ARRIVAL

Early dismissal and late arrival is a privilege awarded to seniors only. Rocky Hill High School continues to be a closed campus for students, meaning students cannot leave and then return to campus during the school day. Parents have the option to allow their senior to arrive late to school and/or leave early from school on days when they do not have a scheduled class during the first or last period. Students must adhere to the following guidelines:

- 1. **Late Arrival-** Seniors who do not have any assigned period 1 class may arrive immediately prior to the start of their next class. Students must report through the main office to scan in for general building attendance.
- Early Dismissal- All students MUST leave immediately at the end of their scheduled classes if
 they have been approved for early dismissal. Students DO NOT have the option of staying in the
 building. Students must scan out/sign out in the main lobby before exiting the building. They
 may not return until the end of the school day if they are involved in sports or other
 school-sponsored activities.
- 3. Students are expected to follow all school rules and regulations. Students reported causing a problem in school, on school grounds, or in the community during the late arrival or early dismissal period will lose the privilege.
- 4. Students must have passed all their classes the prior semester.

5. **SPECIAL NOTES:**

- All students must apply **EACH SEMESTER**.
- Schedules will <u>not</u> be changed for the purpose of this privilege.
- Requests for these privileges must be in writing and must include the signatures of the student and parent/guardian.
- Students must have a 90% daily attendance rate. Students who attempt to circumvent the regulations (i.e. have excessive parent-authorized dismissals, have excessive tardies to school, etc.) will be subject to review by administration with possibility of being disqualified for the late arrival/early dismissal privileges.
- Maintain a cumulative grade point average equivalent to a C- (1.7). If a student has one F on their report in any quarter, the student will lose privilege for the next quarter. If a student loses the privilege for a quarter they may reapply for reinstatement at the end of the marking period.
