



COVID-19 General Notification Letter in Educational Setting

9/22/21

Dear Staff, Parents, and Guardians,

We have been notified on 9/22/21 of a probable or confirmed COVID-19 case amongst a *vaccinated* student, teacher, staff member, coach, volunteer, or any other person who was present on Huron ISD property or at a school function under circumstances that may result in the transmission or contraction of COVID-19 during their infectious period.

- **If you were identified as a close contact with a confirmed individual, you will or have been contacted by the Huron ISD and/or the Huron County Health Department. Please follow the recommendations that are provided regarding your testing, quarantine, masking, monitoring and/or return date. Information provided could be different for everyone based on their circumstance of contact identified.**
 - All unvaccinated close contacts should be isolated and quarantined for 7-days, and can return on day 8 with a negative test (hospital grade rapid or PCR), or return after 10-days with no test, from last exposure in order to prevent illness in new persons. Electing either option, close contact should continue to monitor for symptoms for 14-days. “Close contact” means being a household or staff member, intimate contact, or caregiver of a confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case; within 6 feet of the confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case for more than 15 mins in a 24-hr. period.
 - Fully vaccinated close contacts should monitor for symptoms for 14-days and seek a COVID test 3-5 days after date of exposure.
- Cleaning and disinfecting of the exposed location has or will be completed immediately.
- Please note that all information, including the name(s) of ill persons, is confidential in order to protect patient privacy.
- In accordance with MDHHS Emergency Order Under MCL 333.2253 – Reporting of Confirmed and Probable Cases of COVID-19 at Schools, This notice has been posted within 24 hours to the district website on 9/10/21.
