## WHAT ARE WE LEARNING AT JES?

**PK** - observing nature; shapes; problem solving; ocean

**K** - ELA - knowledge stories, characters, setting and plot Math - comparing numbers to 0-10

**1** - ELA- finishing folk tales and fairy tales and beginning ancient civilizations

Math - Subtracting Strategies to 20

**2** - ELA- Ancient Civilization of Greece and Greek myths Math - strategies to subtract within 100

**3**-ELA - The Human Body: Systems and Senses

Math - Multiplication and Division facts within 100

**4** -ELA - building background knowledge; animal defenses; research process

Math - division; finding quotients and partial quotients, estimating, and interpreting remainders
