AASA State Testing

Our 5th grade students will be taking the AZ Science Test and 3rd – 6th graders will be taking the AASA State Tests on the computer. This is district wide in writing, reading, and math. The testing window is March 21st – April 29th. During this time, our computer lab and classroom mobile labs will be used for testing. AZ Science will take place from March 21st – April 1st (5th grade).

Healthy Hygiene Habits

Beware of Scorpion Weed

With the warmer weather approaching, we will soon be seeing signs of scorpion weed blooming. Please be aware of this plant. It has dark green leaves with a dark purple bloom. The name scorpion weed comes from the small hair-like projections on the stalk. Watch for a local itchy rash similar to poison oak or ivy, usually on hands, legs, and feet.
