For 4 years, students are told that maintaining strong grades and consistency will be recognized. However, my experience suggests that this isn't true. Despite maintaining honor roll status and a GPA above 3.0 throughout high school, one bad grade in a single semester has outweighed years of effort. This feels especially discouraging given the circumstances surrounding this semester. During my senior year, I have been dealing with ongoing physical and mental health challenges, including severe migraines that significantly impact my daily functioning, as well as the loss of both of my grandparents in a horrific house fire. Even so, I continued attending school when I could and have done my best to keep up academically. The current policy doesn't account for long-term performance or significant personal hardship. Instead, it places full weight on a single moment, which can invalidate years of work. If the goal is to support and recognize students, there should be more flexibility and consideration for individual circumstances. Otherwise, the message being sent is that consistency, and effort only matter until one difficult period. It all feels like a major stab in the back.
