What's Happening:

Happy November! We are continually learning new things every day. We are busy working on numbers and learning about our Superkid, Golly and will be introduced to Alf next week.

We have been working on writing and recognizing all the upper and lower case letters of the alphabet and numbers 0-20. We will keep working on writing letters and numbers every day.

We have started to identify onset (beginning sound) and rime (ending sound) of a word, identifying and producing rhyming words, as well as beginning, middle, and ending sounds in words. In the coming weeks we will start working on addition and subtraction equations to 5.

ABC Letter Sounds & Names:

Keep practicing saying their letter names and sounds at home. I highly encourage students go through these cards nightly.

Sight Words:

I highly encourage students go through these cards' multiple times a week. Keep working on Quarter 1 & 2.

Monthly Reading Log:

Complete as many of the challenges as you can before Thursday, November 30, 2023. Those students who have submitted October's Reading Challenge and approved your Pizza Hut participation, you will receive a Pizza Hut Book It! certificate emailed to you or it will be attached to this newsletter.

Academic Standards

Math:

1. Count to 100 by 1's, 2's, 5's, and 10's.
2. Can count forward beyond 20.
3. Can count backwards from 20 consecutively.
4. Can write & identify numbers 0-20 and make a model.
5. Students can add and subtract numbers to 5.
6. Students can compare three shapes and describe their similarities and differences using attributes and vocabulary.
7. Students can sort objects into groups.

Reading:

1. Know letter names & sounds.
2. Fluently read all Quarter 1 & 2 sight words.
3. Students can blend the onset (beginning sound) and rime (ending sound) of a word.
4. Students can say beginning, middle, and end sounds of a word.
5. Students can identify and produce words that rhyme.

Writing:

1. Students can create a piece of functional writing.
2. Write all letters of the alphabet.
3. Students can sort and create a rule for objects they are giving, and verbally explain their rule.

Science:

1. Dealing with Weather
*Weather Conditions, weather patterns, weather hazards, and energy from the sun.

Social Studies:

1. I can recognize that my classmates have different traditions that may be alike in some ways and different in others.
2. I can explain and explore American holidays.
