**jagged** – having rough sharp points that stick out.

**peaks** – the pointed top of the mountain.

<u>tufts</u> – a bunch of grass grown together<u>smoothed</u> – to make even or level.

pasture – land that animals graze on; a meadow.

plucking - to pick or pull off
