Please review the following table listing our schools. For the 2021–2022 school year, schools were identified using new definitions and labels as required by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming subgroups. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is a school that has one to three underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performances is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no status label is given.
