SUBJECT: CES Principal's Report to the CSD School Board

This report covers the period between the May and June board meetings.

Academics

Students took their Q3 STAR assessments in May. Third graders increased their percentile rank (measured against other 3rd graders nationally) by 5% in reading (44th percentile to 49th percentile). 5th graders decreased their percentile rank by 1%, from 34th to 33rd percentile.

Infrastructure and Facilities: Facilities is working hard to ensure repairs are made and that teachers moving classrooms have the support they need to ensure that classroom moves are smooth. Cholla and her team will paint several 5/6 classrooms over the summer.

Staffing: We continue to fill positions as staff shifts to different grades and content areas. A newly-created Title Reading Support position (classified) has been filled, as have our PE and open kindergarten positions. We will continue to post and fill positions as needed throughout the summer.

Sixth Grade Promotion: It was exciting to see more than 70 6th graders celebrate their promotion to 7th grade. Naomi Timreck and Jesse Leavy received the Norma Simmons Award, and Rooney Sanchez received the Grade 6 Principals Award.

Kindergarten Parent Night: Thirty parents came to Parent Night on June 10th. It was exciting to meet incoming kindergarteners, and we could feel their anticipation. We have 30 kindergarteners registered.
