Admission

Admission fee is \$5.00 for ages 3 & up. Ages 2 & under are free.

Prize Package

There will be a winner and a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd runner-up in each division. Winners will receive a crown, banner, and trophy. Runners-up in each division will also receive a trophy. Optional winners will receive a trophy or medallion. Every contestant will receive participation award.

Flowers

Flowers may be ordered in advance with prepayment. The cost is \$25.

Attire

Contestants will be presented in formal wear. Each contestant should wear a dress appropriate for their age. The dress may be long or short. The dress, hair, and make-up style will be left up to the contestants and may be glitz or not. We suggest you wear whatever makes you feel your best.

Eligibility

To qualify for the Miss Bulldog Pride Pageant, contestants must be a Lanier County Resident and those enrolled in school must be in good academic and behavior standing. Contestants must never have been married, have children, nor have been convicted of a crime. There is no discrimination due to race, creed, color, religion, or national origin.

People's Choice Queen

We will also be crowning a Miss Bulldog Pride People's Choice Queen in each division. The contestant in each group with the most \$1 votes the night of the pageant will receive a crown and banner. Envelopes will be provided for each contestant.

Pageant Meeting & Rehearsal

Mandatory Pageant Meeting Monday, March 2 at 5:30 pm in the auditorium. All questions and/or concerns about the pageant will be answered at this time. Rehearsal will be held during this time as well.

Pageant Day

Doors will open Saturday, March 7 at 12:00 pm. This time may be used for extra stage practice if needed. Each contestant will be allowed one helper backstage. No men will be allowed in the contestant dressing rooms.

Judging

Judges will judge each contestant on beauty, poise, and personality. Judges will be qualified, fair, and balanced.

Deadline to Enter

The entry deadline is **February 27, 2026**. All applications, sponsorship payments, and flower prepayments (if purchasing) — excluding People's Choice — must be received by this date. No applications will be accepted after February 27, 2026.
