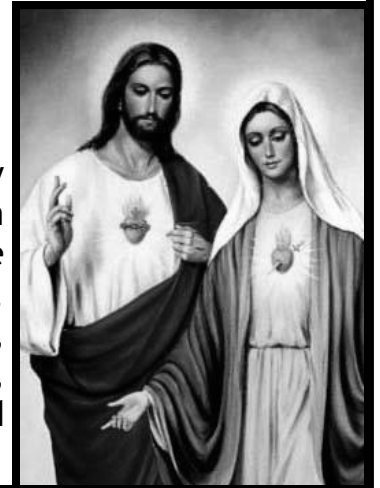


INTERESTED IN BEING CONSECRATED?

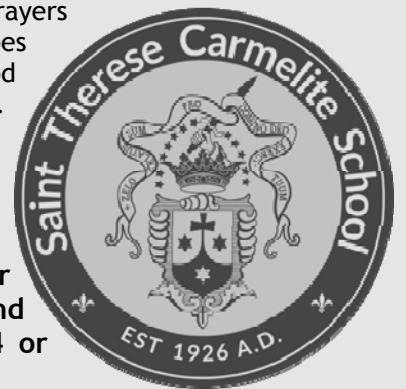
Deeply rooted in Carmelite spirituality, Saint Therese Carmelite School seeks to form students in faith, academics, and virtue through a Classical education.

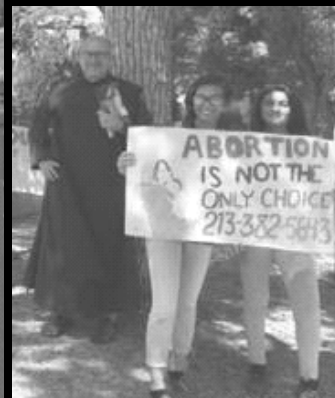

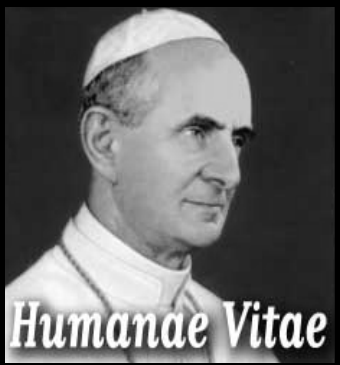
For Youth (Days) and Adults (Evenings)
