

Prepare for your visit to College + Career Day

- Talk to a parent/guardian before and after your visit to get feedback on your options.
- Know your personal information:
 - Valid email address you check
 - Telephone number
 - Mailing address
 - Accurate GPA and ACT score
 - Social security number
- Research colleges, military branches, and companies attending and know what they offer. Use the Career Coach Resource Site online for help with some of these topics.
 - What do you want to major in and what schools offer it?
 - Are you unsure what to study? Take a career interest inventory.
- Make a list of questions you need answered, particularly ones you cannot find on a website.
 - Always think through this question - "What do I need to know to help me make a decision?"
 - Also ask about deadlines for applications, housing, scholarships, and other forms of financial aid.
 - Want to go test-optional? Ask about their current policies
- Job Hunting? Bring an updated resume or have one accessible to email from your phone.
- Dress well - it's an informal interview!
- Stay off your phone, make eye contact, and smile!
