MODEL 2024 TITLE IX NOTICE OF EXTENSION

- On a case-by-case basis, the Title IX Grievance Process may be temporarily delayed or extended for good cause. Good cause may include, but is not limited to: the unavailability of a party or a witness; concurrent law enforcement or other agency activity; or the need for language assistance or accommodation of disabilities.
- Complainant and Respondent, as appropriate, must be provided written notice of the delay/extension and the reason(s) for it.
- Note: The Title IX regulations do not specify how notice must be provided. We recommend written notice. PRESS sample policy 2:265 and the corresponding administrative procedures specify that the notice must be in writing.
