Emergency Medical Responder (EMR)

This program is for High School Students who are in 11th/12th grade, are physically and mentally capable of dealing with the physical and mental stress of encountering and providing pre-hospital assessment and care for patients of all ages with a variety of medical conditions and traumatic injuries. Student must show the ability to be organized and have a history of being prepared for class. Student should be academically capable, self—motivated, have limited minor discipline issues, and have a positive attendance record. For admission into this program, the student's High School submits an application to the district committee. If the student meets the program requirements, WEIC contacts the parent/guardian to set up an interview. Please contact your student's school counselor for more information.
