2024-2025 Supply List

The items listed below are what all classrooms in your child's grade level will use. Your child's teacher may send a list with a few additional items that are specific to her classroom needs.

# Kindergarten

Backpack (regular size; no wheels – great to have one you can wash)

#### **Boys and Girls**

- \*4 boxes 24 count Crayola crayons
- \*4 glue sticks
- \*4 boxes Kleenex tissues
- \*2 PRIMARY journals (not a composition book – says Primary Journal on cover)
- 3 containers Clorox/Lysol wipes Headphones (with circular jack; no earbuds)

#### Boys

\*2 packs 24 count #2 pencils (American Gold or Ticonderoga if possible; pre-sharpened if possible) Quart Ziploc bags 1 pack white cardstock

#### Girls

\*1 bottle hand sanitizer Paper towels Snack size Ziploc bags 1 pack colored paper (like Astrobrights)

#### Wish List

Soft Candy Treats such as Skittles, Smarties, gummy bears, Play-Doh

### 1st Grade

Backpack (regular size; no wheels – great to have one you can wash)

#### **Student Supplies**

- \*1 Mead Primary Journal (Half-page ruled, 5/8 top-half is empty for drawing a picture (100 page count)
- \*Headphones(circular jack; no Bluetooth)
- \*1 pair blunt tip scissors (like Fiskars for kids)
- \*4 glue sticks
- \*1 bottle Elmer's liquid glue
- \*3 boxes 24 count Crayola crayons
- \*3 packs #2 pencils (American Gold or Ticonderoga if possible; pre-sharpened if possible)
- \*1 plastic crayon box (to fit glue, crayons, pencils – write child's name on it with black Sharpie)

#### **Cleaning Supplies**

Girls - 1 box Kleenex tissues Boys - 1 roll paper towels 1 container Clorox/Lysol wipes

(Only put names on backpack, crayon box, and writing journal)

# 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

Backpack (regular size; no wheels – great to have one you can wash)

- \*2 packs 24 count #2 pencils (American Gold or Ticonderoga if possible; pre-sharpened if possible)
- \*4 glue sticks
- \*2 boxes 24 count Crayola crayons
- \*1 one inch 3 ring binder with interior pockets and clear sleeve on front and back
- \*1 pair blunt tip scissors (like Fiskars for kids)
- \*Headphones(circular jack; no Bluetooth, no earbuds))

#### Girls-

- 1 container Clorox wipes
- 1 roll paper towels
- 1 box Kleenex

#### Boys-

- 1 pack black Expo markers
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer
- 1 box band-aids

# 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade

Backpack (regular size; no wheels – great to have one you can wash)

- \*2 packs 24 count #2 pencils (American Gold or Ticonderoga if possible; pre-sharpened if possible)
- \*2 packs pencil top/cap erasers
- \*2 yellow highlighters
- \*1 pack BLACK fine tip expo markers (only black)
- \*2 packs wide ruled notebook paper
- \*2 boxes 24 count Crayola crayons
- \*Headphones (circular jack; no Bluetooth)
- 3 containers Clorox/Lysol wipes
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer
- 3 boxes Kleenex tissues

## 4th Grade

Backpack (regular size; no wheels – great to have one you can wash)

- \*1 package loose leaf wide ruled notebook paper
- \*2 packs 24 count #2 pencils (American Gold or Ticonderoga if possible; pre-sharpened if possible)
- \*1 pack of white lunch bags
- \*2 boxes Cravola cravons
- \*1 zipper pouch/back for crayons, pencils, etc.
- \*Headphones/Earbuds (circular jack; no Bluetooth)
- 2 containers Clorox wipes
- 2 rolls paper towels
- 2 boxes Kleenex tissues
- 1 box Zip-lock storage bags (any size)
