Dear Parents & Guardians,

The West Point Consolidated School District will be participating in the Free & Reduced Meal Price Program for lunch and Provision 2 meal program for breakfast for the 2026-2027 school year. All students will receive a free breakfast but will be required to complete an application for lunch to determine free, reduced or paid status.

The Free & Reduced meal price program is confidential, easy and can help both your budget and your child's school.

The West Point Consolidated School District Child Nutrition Program will accept free and reduced meal applications throughout the school year. Students approved for free or reduced priced meals may eat lunch free or at a reduced cost.

A new application must be completed every year.

Electronic forms will be available at the district wide registration event. This event will be held on July 16th and 17th. All parents will be required to complete an application as part of the registration process. Electronic forms will be provided to all parents during registration. Paper and electronic applications will be available year-round at all district and school offices.

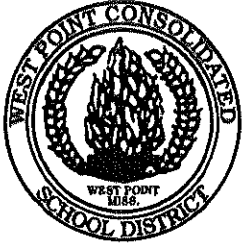
Return only **ONE** application per family. It is best to complete/return at your youngest child's school. Parents must list all students related to the single application.

Grace period for returning students:

Students will receive meals based on their previous year's eligibility for the first 30 days of school. This means that all returning students will receive free meals for the first 30 days of school. To ensure continued eligibility, please submit and have your application processed by August 24, 2026. **If an application is not received by this date, your child's meal status will default to full pay.**

Eligibility for free and reduced price meal is not retroactive. School meals must be paid for until the free and reduced application is approved.

Incomplete, illegible, or incorrect applications cannot be processed. Therefore, student(s) on the application will have to pay full price for meals.
