## BUS INFORMATION

### BUS SURVEY:

If you did not complete the transportation survey at the end of the student registration process please do so **as soon as possible** **HERE!** This is important so that we can make sure your student has a spot on the bus. The survey must be completed for EACH student enrolling in the Seaside School District, regardless of whether or not your student is planning on riding the bus. We must hear from every student.



### BUS REMINDERS:

Here are some bus reminders from our transportation department:

- Please keep students home if they are sick!
- Please arrive to the bus stop 5 minutes before the pickup time
- Seat assignments may be implemented
- Remember to dress warmly, windows may be open for fresh air
- New student routing may take up to five business days
- Students are required to scan their Student ID to enter & exit the bus
