- 1. There will be absolutely no bus switching to and from Gradnite. Buses leave SMHS at <u>6:00 a.m.</u> from Thornburg Street. Be there by <u>5:30 a.m.</u>!
- 2. No alcohol, drugs, tobacco or other contraband allowed on the bus. Purses, backpacks, and jackets, etc. will be searched. Santa Maria High School will check all blankets, pillows, hair spray, and personal items thoroughly!!! BACKPACKS ARE ALLOWED ON THE BUS AND IN DISNEYLAND BUT THEY WILL BE CHECKED THOROUGHLY! NO FRUIT, FOOD, COOLERS, OPEN CANS, BOTTLES, OR CONTAINERS ALLOWED ON BUS!! A DRUG DOG WILL BE PRESENT AT DISNEYLAND! Water and some snacks will be provided for the trip down and back. Be sure to eat before you get on the bus. You will get a bag lunch on the trip to Disneyland as part of the cost of the GradNite ticket.
- 3. The only drugs allowed on the trip will be prescription drugs. However, it is Disneyland's policy to give your prescriptions to your chaperone as you board the bus at SMHS. The chaperone will be the only person allowed to bring medication into the Park Area. When you need any medication, you will need to contact your chaperone.
- 4. Disneyland Security will be searching for you at the Entrance Gates. Their search is much more thorough than ours!!! If contraband is found on your person, the following will result:
 - a) Parents will be contacted to pick you up at Disneyland.
 - b) You will not be able to participate in any remaining Senior activities.
 - c) You will not participate in graduating on stage.
- 5. If you are caught shoplifting, committing any crime, or breaking Santa Maria Joint Union High School District major discipline policy(ies), the same consequences apply as in #4 above. You also risk the chance of being arrested.
- 6. All students are to remain at Disneyland, California Adventure, or Downtown Disney during GradNite activities. Any student that leaves these areas at any time will face the same consequences as outlined in #4 above.
- Disneyland has a dress policy. In addition, you will follow <u>SMHS's dress code</u>: NO TORN OR REVEALING CLOTHING. Do wear comfortable shoes. You may wear appropriate shorts and/or comfortable clothing. Please bring warmer clothing to use later in the evening. Please bring blankets and pillows with you to use on the bus.
- 8. The buses WILL NOT be stopping on the way down and back. Please do not drink too many liquids.
- 9. If your bus leaves Disneyland as planned (around 2:30 a.m.) you should arrive in Santa Maria sometime between 5 a.m. and 7 a.m. on Wednesday, May 31, 2023.
- 10. Please keep the buses neat and clean. Don't jeopardize next year's Gradnite.
- 11. Have a great time and enjoy yourself!!!
- 12. IF YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR SENIOR PRIVILEGES ON May 30, 2023, YOU WILL <u>NOT</u> BE REFUNDED YOUR MONEY! YOU WILL BE PULLED FROM THE BUS LINE IF YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR SENIOR PRIVILEGES-WITHOUT REIMBURSEMENT!
- 13. <u>All buses must be at full capacity</u> (50 students per bus). If the last bus is not at full capacity by March 15, 2023, then you will be put on a waiting list. Students on the waiting list are not guaranteed a ticket/participation because ticket prices are based on a FULL bus. Sign up early!
