## REGISTRATION FOR NEW STUDENTS IN THE RHEA COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM

Students who did not attend school in the Rhea County School System during the School Year 2022-2023, and students who will be changing schools in the Rhea County School System during School Year 2023-2024, can register early by going to their respective school on the following dates:

Frazier Elementary School	July 24 – 28 from 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.
Graysville Elementary School	July 24 – 28 from 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.
<b>Rhea Central Elementary School</b>	July 24 – 28 from 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.
<b>Spring City Elementary School</b>	July $24 - 28$ from 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.

Rhea Middle School

July 24 – 28 from 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.

Spring City Middle School

July 24 – 28 from 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.

Rhea County High School July 24 – 28 from 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.

## **Excluded from the new student early registration dates are:**

- ✓ Rising ninth graders who registered at Rhea County High School earlier in the 2022-2023 school year,
- ✓ Rising sixth graders for Rhea Middle and Spring City Middle who registered during 2022-2023 school year, and
- ✓ Kindergarten students who registered early for this coming school year.

## Registration requirements for new students previously enrolled in another school system last year are:

2022-2023 Report Card; name, address and phone number of last school attended; immunization records; social security number, and proof of residence (most recent utility bill with correct address-not P.O. box). Students who will be entering school for the first time must bring their birth certificate or hospital record; immunization and medical record; social security number and proof of residence. **Kindergarten students must be five years old on or before August 15, 2023.** 

OTHER INFORMATION: Wednesday, August 2, 2023, will be HALF Day for students. NO BUS TRANSPORTATION WILL BE PROVIDED ON AUGUST 2 AT ANY SCHOOL.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Wednesday, Aug. 2, at Rhea Co. High will be for Ninth (9<sup>th</sup>) grade students <u>ONLY</u>.

Wednesday, Aug. 2, Rhea Middle Sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) grade students Orientation in Little Theater. Rhea Middle 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade-Class Schedule pick up in Gym Lobby ONLY

Wednesday, Aug. 2, Spring City Middle School 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> will report to pick up Class schedules.
