Parents/Students: please read the guidelines thoroughly:

- 1) Acts should be no longer than 2 minutes in length. Any act longer than 2 minutes will not be allowed to participate.
- 2) Absolutely no lip-synching allowed. No CDs/tapes with lead vocals – karaoke music works great.
- 3) Bring all necessary equipment and props for your audition, rehearsal, and performance dates. Please label the CD/tape with your name, your teacher's name, and the track # of the song. A CD/tape player will be provided for the audition, rehearsal, and performances.
- 4) If you burn your CD, make sure to “finalize” it, and please ensure it can be heard before the auditions!
- 5) Acts are judged on content, originality, appropriateness, creativity & organization.
- 6) Acts and costumes must be **school appropriate**.
(**Parents:** Please review your child's talent show material to ensure it is school appropriate. If in doubt, pick other material!)

PARENTS/STUDENTS: We want all 3rd through 5th-grade students to be able to participate in the auditioning process. But we need your help too! Please read the following carefully.

Permission slips **MUST** be turned in **before THE AUDITIONS**. Please turn the slips into Mrs. Dunn by 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, March 22, 2023. **The permission slips must be filled out entirely and signed by a parent for the student to audition.** Once auditions are completed, the students will return to class. Good luck, students!
