The scholarship money will be sent to an acceptable institute only.

To have the money sent to the institute you need to:

1. Enroll in the school within 2 years.
2. Setup an account with the financial department.
3. Send the information to the above address,
Include your student ID number,
Name and address of the school.
4. Present the first transcript of grades to prove you are in school.
5. This scholarship is void if not used within 2 years 6 months,
6. If the scholarship is for an accredited vocational institution and need the scholarship to purchase initial required supplies or equipment the money can be sent upon acceptance to the institution.
