To have the money sent to the institute you need to:

- 1. Enroll in the school within 2 years.
- 2. Setup an account with the financial department.
- Send the information to the above address, Include your student ID number, Name and address of the school.
- 4. Present the first transcript of grades to prove you are in school.
- 5. This scholarship is void if not used within 2 years 6 months,
- 6. If the scholarship is for an accredited vocational institution and need the scholarship to purchase initial required supplies or equipment the money can be sent upon acceptance to the institution.
