

## 2022 Cannery Schedule

The Murray County Cannery will be open from 8:00 AM until noon on the following dates:

July 19-21

July 25-28

August 1-4

August 8 and 9 (By Appointment Only)

Information:

1. Arrive by 9:00 a.m. so that items can be prepared and processed by noon. It is possible that items will be too hot to take home and will need to be picked up the next day.
2. Processing glass jars is .40 cents each. Customers must provide their own jars with new flats and rings.
3. The cannery provides 20ounce cans for customers that wish to use them. To process items in cans is .60 cents each, including the cost of the cans.
4. Customers should bring all items needed including measuring spoons or cups, seasonings, can-openers (if making Taco Soup or other foods that require opening cans), and canning salt.
5. Fresh green beans should be ready to wash and pack upon arrival (i.e., strung and broken.)
6. Items such as dried beans, green beans, tomatoes, salsa, relish, taco soup, spaghetti sauce, apple butter, etc. are the most common items that customers process.
7. Customers must prepare and pack their own jars/cans. Cannery staff is there to assist, advise, and operate the equipment.
8. The cannery does not process meat or meat-containing foods.
9. The Cannery is a brick building located on Magnolia Street behind the Murray County Schools Pre-K and Early Learning Center (old Bagley Middle School building.)
