

Due to the weather forecast on Friday, the Franklin County School District is making plans to possibly relocate the graduation ceremony to the High School Auditorium. If this occurs the following guidelines will be followed:

1. Each senior will receive 6 stamped tickets to enter the High School Auditorium. You must have one of the stamped tickets to enter the Auditorium. (This will be strictly enforced)
2. Each senior will receive 5 additional tickets without the stamp mentioned above to enter the High School Gymnasium where the graduation ceremony will be projected live on a large screen. You must have one of the tickets without the stamp to enter the Gymnasium. (This will be strictly enforced). Seats will be available on the Home side of the gym and on temporary bleachers on the gym floor.
3. Seating at both locations will be first come- first serve. Saving seats for family members that have not arrived will not be allowed due to the seating capacity of the auditorium and gymnasium.
4. All other family members will have the capability of watching the graduation ceremony live from any location by visiting www.franklinadvocate.com and clicking on the banner at the top of the webpage.
5. Current students that are not graduates must have a ticket to be admitted into either location.
6. A final decision on the graduation location will be made by the Franklin County School District by noon Wednesday, May 15th.
