Senior Checklist: All parents of seniors should have received a checklist in the mail of what their student has left to do for graduation requirements. Mrs. Kramer has met with seniors to remind them of what they have left to do during English 12 classes. Here is a quick list of what everyone needs to do:

- Graduation pathways box one: be on track to earn your diploma
- Graduation pathways box two: show employability skills- students need to turn in their one page page with five job skills/one strength/one weakness and their rating form
- Graduation pathways box three: complete one post-secondary readiness competency from the list

Dual Credit Classes for the 2024-2025 School Year: Tri-Township is offering several dual credit classes next school year for students in grade 9-12. The dual credit classes include Biology II, Introduction to Engineering Design, Principles of Engineering, and Introduction to Agriculture. Any student wishing to earn dual credits for the classes listed above will need to create a Dual Enroll account for Ivy Tech. Students will need to know their social security number to create an account. Students who are freshmen, sophomores, or upperclassmen that don't have a 2.6 GPA and are Core 40 track may need to take the Knowledge Assessment to qualify for a dual credit class.
