POWER	Power off solid red	Power on solid white	Sleep red/white
SWITCH INPUTS	Swipe up	Overlay toolbar/Input	Remote
VOLUME	Main panel	PC Windows	App volumes
CLEANING	Use microfiber cloth	Electronic safe or damp cloth.	Do not spray liquids on panel.

OVERLAY TOOLBAR

HOME		Navigate to Android	Go to Android home screen at any time.
ANNOTATE		Saves to: Android or Cloud Works with: anything	Up to 4 pen colors to annotate over anything.
FREEZE & ZOOM		Works with: anything	Freezes the screen, then pinch & zoom.
SPOTLIGHT		Works with: anything	Pinch to change size. When open, use the gear at the bottom to adjust.
COUNTDOWN TIMER		Works with: anything	Keep track of time in fullscreen or mini.
STOPWATCH		Works with: anything	Time anything in full size or mini.

CHORUS & ZONES

OPENING & FINDING CORNER MENU

Open app on PC or connecting computer.



Swipe to turn spindle. Use **Corner Menu** in bottom corners for tools & navigation.



NAVIGATING

When in an open app, click the **Corner Menu**.




Select Desktop to minimize Chorus



Or select close app to return to spindle.



ZONES



Divide panel into 4 screens simultaneously.



SAVE ZONES

Open at least 2 Zones.



In the **Corner Menu** click **Zones**.



Click **Save current layout**.



ADJUST ZONES

Open at least 2 Zones.



Click **Corner Menu** & **Adjust Zones**.



Drag the orange lines to desired location & click **save**.

SWAP ZONES

Open at least 2 Zones.



Click **Corner Menu** & **Swap Zone**.



Tap the Zone you wish to move it to.

If you see any other symbol, right click, then choose **Open with** then Microsoft Edge




Once open, the annotation tools are on the top left

Touch on the **Review** tab, then **Start Inking** to draw on your document or presentation





Start to write with the tools



HOW TO USE KAMI


STEP 1

Install the **Kami** extension for your browser




STEP 2

Click on the Kami button found at the top of your open Google resource



STEP 3


Use the tools on the left to markup your resources



USING MICROSOFT EDGE

In your Google resource, **download** as a PDF document


Then **open** in the Microsoft Edge to annotate the document



USING WHITEBOARD IN CHORUS


STEP 1

In **Chorus**, open **Whiteboard** in 1 zone and your file from Google docs or OneDrive app in another zone



STEP 2

Use **Screenshot** in the corner menu to send the screenshot to Whiteboard for annotation



CONNECTING EXTERNAL COMPUTERS

STEP 1

Locate HDMI & USB Touch Cables in your Accessory Box



STEP 2

Plug each cord into the ports on your panel. You **MUST** group as shown **here**



STEP 3

Plug the HDMI cable into the desktop or laptop. Then plug the Touch Cable into the computer's USB port



SPECIFICS FOR MAC

Mac devices can be connected 2 ways, either with the adapter or USB-C

Only **1 cable needed**
USB-C delivers video, audio and touch signals



You may need an **adapter** while plugging in the HDMI cable to a Mac Device
