

# HONOR REGALIA

## **ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE / Silver Cord**

*Seniors receiving an academic excellence cord have maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.8 for four years.*

## **ACADEMIC SCHOLAR / Light Blue Stole**

*Students who receive this sash have achieved a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher, completed the minimum University of California A-G requirements for college admission and earned 230 or more course credits.*

## **ADVANCEMENT VIA INDIVIDUAL DETERMINATION / White, Teal & Black Cord**

*Students receiving cords have participated in AVID for a minimum of two years including junior and senior years of high school, have earned a total weighted GPA of 3.0 or higher, completed a minimum of 25 hours of community service, completed rigorous course work (college prep and AP courses), have been involved in extra-curricular activities and have earned acceptance into a four-year university.*

## **AGRICULTURE DEPARTMENT PROGRAM COMPLETERS / Blue Cord & Gold Cord**

*These students are recognized as “completers” within the Agricultural Department.*

## **CALIFORNIA SCHOLARSHIP FEDERATION & NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY / Gold Cord**

*CSF Life Members, also called “Seal-bearers,” are those students who have maintained CSF membership for four semesters from the sophomore to senior year, with at least one membership being during the senior year. Membership is determined largely by the students’ grades in rigorous college-prep, honors and advanced placement classes. These students are also dedicated to character, scholarship, leadership and service.*

## **CREATIVE EXCELLENCE / Medal**

*Recipients are Visual and Performing Arts students who have completed eight terms of VPA courses with a “B” or better and who have contributed to the VPA program throughout their high school career.*

## **FAMILY CAREER & COMMUNITY LEADERS OF AMERICA / Red & White Cord**

*Students are recognized for participating in the FCCLA club for two or more years, a minimum of three club events per year and for completing two or more classes with a “C” or better in the Family & Consumer Sciences Department.*

## **FRENCH HONOR SOCIETY / Blue, White & Red Cord**

*French Honor Society recognizes those students who have taken three or more years of French with an A-average and an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher, and have joined and participated in the honor society.*

## **FUTURE BUSINESS LEADERS OF AMERICA / Gold & Blue Cord**

*FBLA recognizes students for attaining a 3.0 GPA in business classes taken and at least three years chapter membership, with the participation of community service through the campus store.*

## **GSA / Lavender Sash**

*Recipients have a 2.0 GPA, two years active membership and have participated in a minimum of two school events.*

## **KEY CLUB / International Medallion**

*Students receiving this medal have participated in Key Club for two or more years, completed a minimum of 100 hours of community service, maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher and participated in a minimum of two events hosted yearly.*

## **LINK CREW LEADERS / Green Cord**

*Link Crew Leaders receiving this cord have served as role models for two years. These student mentors facilitate freshmen orientation, providing incoming students with a connection to PVHS. They continue to foster this relationship and sense of community throughout the school year.*

**NATIONAL SCIENCE HONOR SOCIETY / Green, Gold & Purple Cord**

*To qualify, students must earn a 3.75 GPA in three advanced science classes their junior and senior years.  
Courses include: AP Biology, AP Environmental Science, Forensics, Physics, Physiology & Anatomy, and Medical Science Health,  
and Sports Medicine Kinesiology.*

**PANTHER TALES / Teal & White Cord**

*Students receiving this cord must have attained an overall 3.0 GPA and two-year membership in the Panther Tales Club with a "B"  
or better  
in Journalism or Publications.*

**PIONEER VALLEY ACADEMIC SASH / White Sash**

*These students have completed specific combinations of CTE Pathways, A-G requirements, SBAC scores, AP exams or concurrent  
enrollment  
and positively contributed to the overall ranking of PVHS.*

**SEAL OF BILITERACY / Certificate and Red, Blue & Gold Cord**

*The Seal of Biliteracy cord is awarded to students who have taken four years of language with a 3.0 GPA or higher. Cords are  
awarded for specific  
combinations of GPA, oral examinations, SBAC, ELPAC and SAT scores.*

**SHARE CLUB / Purple & Orange Cord**

*Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA, have two years membership and plan and organize all major violence prevention awareness  
events  
with communication and leadership.*

**SOCIEDAD HONORARIA HISPÁNICA / Red-Orange & Yellow Cord**

*Members have taken three years of high school Spanish classes and maintained a 3.75 GPA in those classes.*

**STUDENT COUNCIL / Teal & Black Cord / Silver Cord & Sash**

*This cord is awarded to Student Council members who have maintained a 3.0 GPA, served in the Student Council  
for at least 2 years and maintained all As in Student Council. ASB Executives and Class Officers receive the silver cord and silver  
sash.*
