




Purpose of Title I

- Title I is a part of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965.
- Purpose was to give additional resources to states and localities for remedial education for children in poverty.

Reauthorization of Title I

- 1994, Title I shifted the program's emphasis to helping disadvantaged children reach rigorous state academics standards.
- Money can be used for:
 - Instructional activities
 - Parental involvement
 - Program improvement
