MOTION: Mr. Auslander made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda. Dr. Peate seconded; the motion carried unanimously.

5. INFORMATION ITEMS

A. TVHS Student Council Presentation – Mrs.Tiffany Brock the Tanque Verde High School Student Council Sponsor/Teacher presented to board members what the Student Council (STUCO) is doing this year. This year is Mrs. Brocks first year as the Sponsor/Teacher for the Student Council. Her focus is to help students develop Leadership Skills and to learn to recognize their own leadership style – not everyone is the same. Students are also learning and developing organizational and public speaking skills, and the importance of knowing about parliamentary procedures.
