

PHS Student Government Association (SGA)

Congratulations on taking your first step towards becoming a student leader, here, at Prattville High School. By running for a position on this year's SGA, you are making a commitment of time, hard work, attendance, and leadership. The SGA is a service organization that demands leadership not only in the classroom but also in the community. You will be expected to represent Prattville High School to the best of your ability throughout the school year.

If you are running for a position in SGA, you MUST meet the following qualifications:

1. You MUST complete **the entire attached application form** and **return it to the MEDIA CENTER** by **Friday, March 20, 2026, no later than 12:00 NOON! NO EXCEPTIONS without PRIOR APPROVAL.**
2. You MUST have a **minimum of a 3.0 GPA**, including this year's first-semester scores. **The last day to turn in points to qualify for candidacy is Wednesday, March 18, 2026.**
3. You must designate the office you are seeking when you turn in your form. Once your form is submitted, as stated in the bylaws, this cannot be changed.
4. A **clean discipline record** is required. *(Please read the bylaws, posted under the SGA's page link on the school's website under the "Social" tab: www.gophslions.com to fully understand this qualification, and feel free to see Mrs. Roy or Mrs. Mitchell if you have any questions.)*
5. If **running for an executive office**, you MUST have previously and actively served on the SGA for a -minimum of one year and be in good standing.
6. **If you are running as an *Executive or class officer position**, you MUST have **three teachers at PHS**—who have known you for at least **one year**—fill out the attached recommendation forms. **If you are running as a representative**, you MUST have **two teachers at PHS**—who have known you for at least **one year**—fill out the attached recommendation forms. It is your responsibility to get the forms to them well-before the application's deadline, **Friday, March 20, 2026, no later than 12:00 NOON.** *(The names of all applicants will be shared with the faculty and staff for additional reference concerns and/or questions.)*
