OUR LEARNING

Reading-I can listen to a story. I can answer questions about a story.

Phonics- I can say the names of letters and their sounds. I can put sounds together to form CVC words.

Writing: I can write my letters correctly. I can write a complete sentence starting with a capital letter and ending with punctuation.

Math-I can say and write numbers 1-30. I can add and subtract within 10. I can complete a pattern. I can use tally marks. I can use the part-part-whole model to understand addition.

Science/Social Studies- I can understand fire safety.
