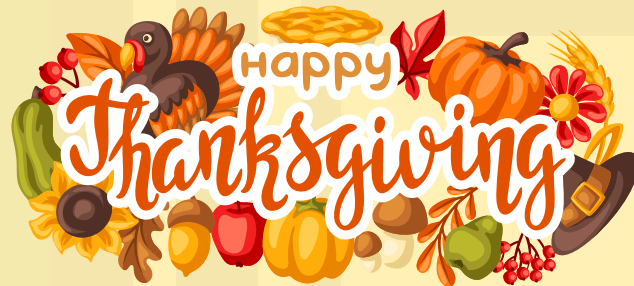

When to keep your child at home:

If your child has a fever (above 100 degrees or higher) please keep them home until they have been fever free without a fever reducer. If your child has diarrhea consisting of three or more watery or loose stools in 24 hours, this could be an indication that the cold is contagious. Please keep your child home.

If your child has vomited two or more times in the past 24 hours or has other flu like symptoms they should not attend school.

Children who have bloodshot eyes with yellow drainage may have conjunctivitis. Children with pinkeye should not attend school until they have consulted their doctor.

If your child has a skin rash and the cause of the skin rash is unknown it is best to consult a physician before sending the child to school. Some rashes are contagious and need to be treated before returning to school.

When your child's sore throat is accompanied by a fever or is very inflamed, he/she should stay home. Not all sore throats will warrant a day home from school.

If you have any questions regarding whether or not to send your child to school you can contact the school nurse by calling the school or emailing.
