- September 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> the Office of Safe Schools conducted training for principals and threat management team members of each school.
- Leon County Safety Team came to GCHS to see a demo of our new portable metal detectors.
- The safety department has trained approximately 10 new substitute teachers this month with the crisis response manual and the active assailant procedures & response.
- Attended Office of Safe School new portal training online.
- Conducting safety checks while walking through campuses weekly.
- Attended several school-based threat management team meetings and assisted with threat assessments.
- Attended the college fair at GCHS and assisted with ISS due to a staff shortage.
- Completed a School Safety Specialist webinar provided by FS3 and OSS.
- While conducting campus walk throughs, I discovered several safety issues and submitted work orders for repair.
- Conducted active assailant drills at several schools and assisted with documentation.
- Prepared and maintained a Threat Assessment log for compliance.
- September 23<sup>rd</sup>, the Office of Safe Schools will be conducting another Day 1 threat management training for new district staff.
- Will be attending the District School Board Meeting on September 23, 2025.

- \* Gadsden County High School (GCHS) Implemented student security scan system; set-up completed and fully operational; Installed and tested HonorLock for the Dual Enrollment program; system is fully functional.
- ❖ George W. Munroe (GWM) Installed a new 2-way radio system for intercom and safety communication, replacing the damaged paging system (struck by lightning); Repaired the staff gate twice within the last 30 days to ensure safety and accessibility.
- \* West Gadsden Middle School (WGMS) Reconfigured and restored ExactVision camera system, which had been disabled due to a lightning strike.
- ❖ Greensboro Elementary (GEB) Replaced and set up TrueTime iPad for staff use.
