2023 St. George High Class of 1977 Scholarship Awards Program. Under the Program, two (2) scholarship in the amounts of a \$500.00 and a \$300.00 is available to be awarded to a Woodland High School Senior entering an accredited college or university in 2023.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

* Seeking graduating seniors with a record of volunteerism in community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.

* Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college/university or technical school.

* Scholarship funds will be paid in the first semester of the student's verified enrollment, directly to the college and not to the student. Scholarship awards will be payable to the college only. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to this organization, student ID number and college information.

* The St. George High Class of 1977 Scholarship packet must include the scholarship application, 500 word essay typed with Time New Romans font size of 12, double spaced, 1 inch margin and neat on the subject announced, resume with photo, recommendation/reference letter school transcripts and college acceptance letter to be deemed and stamped complete. Application deadline is **February 28, 2023** and must be postmarked and received by The St. George High Class of 1977 Scholarship Committee (Incomplete package or Late applications will not accepted).

* The applications will be reviewed and evaluated by a Scholarship Selection Committee selected by the Scholarship Committee consisting of volunteers based on the following criteria:

•Demonstrated academic ability - Applicants must provide school transcripts. A minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 is required to be eligible for scholarship funding.

•Demonstrated writing ability – Applicants must submit an essay on the topic listed in the application.

•School activities – Applicants should list all school activities and explain which activity is most important and why.

•Community activities – Applicants should list all community activities unrelated to school and explain which activity is most important and why.

•February 28, 2023 - Application Deadline

•April 15 - April 30 2023 - Recipient are notified by mail

•July 2023 - Checks are processed and distributed to attending schools by The St. George High Class of 1977 Scholarship Committee
