We know that students are eagerly anticipating their class placement. We are still accepting students and are planning to distribute this information in late August. Thank you for your patience.

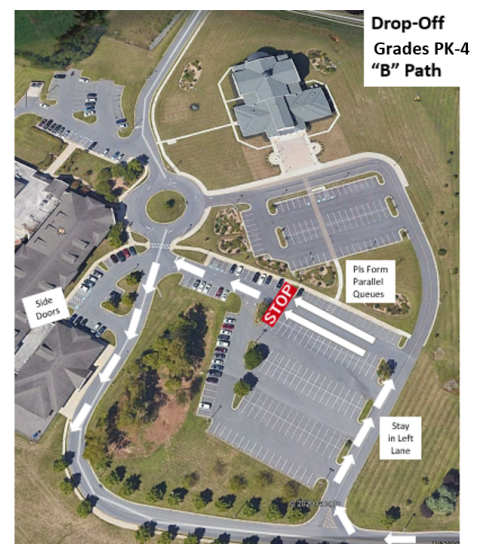
School Hours

Morning drop-off will begin at 7:50 a.m. until 8:10 a.m. when the tardy bell rings for morning announcements. Afternoon pick-up will begin at 2:30 p.m. for PreK3, 2:40 p.m. for PreK4, and 2:50 p.m. for grades K-8. Half-day noon dismissal pick-up will begin at 11:30 a.m. for PreK3, 11:40 a.m. for PreK4, and 11:50 a.m. for grades K-8. Grade levels will be assigned specific entry/exit doors to the building during drop-off and pick-up.

Morning Drop Off Procedures

Between 7:50 a.m. – 8:10 a.m. cars will line up according to their oldest child's grade level.

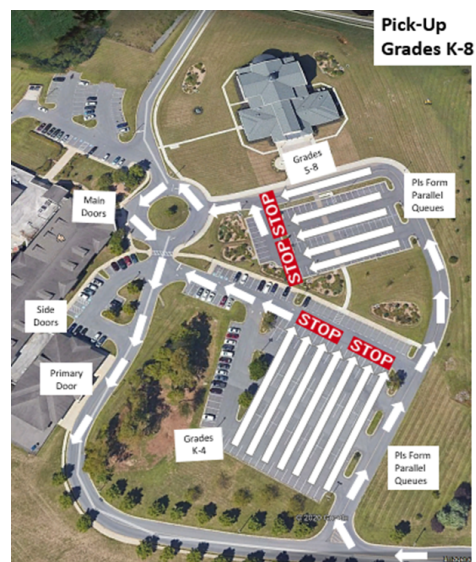
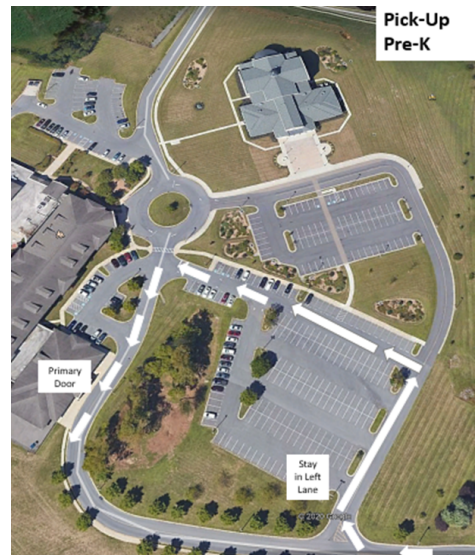
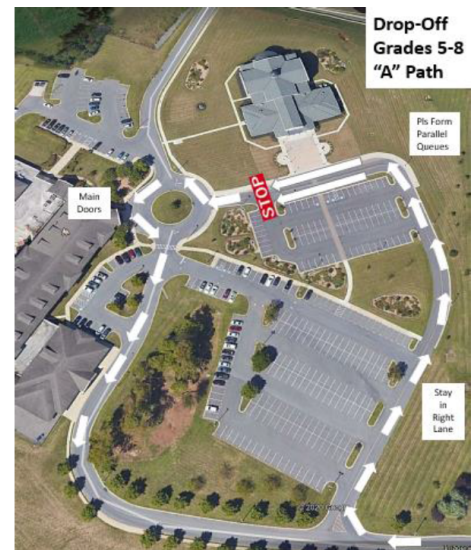
- Grades PreK – 4 will:
 - Enter from the East entrance. Please follow the "B" path and form two lines in the large parking lot.
 - At the fire hydrant merge into a single lane before proceeding to the Primary Wing entrance for drop off.
 - PreK to 1st-grade students will enter the primary wing entrance and proceed to their homeroom.
 - Students in Grades 2 - 4 will exit their vehicle and walk along the sidewalk on the admin parking lot to enter the building in the green side door entrance and proceed to their homeroom.



- Grades 5-8 will:
 - From the East entrance please follow the “A” path in front of the church and form two lines.
 - Wait at the stop sign to merge into a single lane before proceeding to the main entrance for drop off.
 - Students will exit the vehicle (from the passenger side) enter the main entrance, and proceed to their homeroom.
 - Students must never exit the vehicle from the driver's side.

Afternoon Pick-Up Procedures

- Prekindergarten
 - PreK3 students will be dismissed at 2:30 p.m. at the primary entrance.
 - Students in PreK4 will be dismissed at 2:40 p.m. at the primary entrance.
 - Please enter our campus and create a single queue using only the main entrance. If you have children in other grade levels please join those respective queues after collecting your Pre-K student.
- Grades K-4
 - Dismissal begins at 2:50 p.m.
 - Students will be exiting the same door into which they entered during arrival and meet their family pick up in the SJRCS parking lot.
 - Please enter our campus using the main entrance and queue using our traditional stadium layout in the large parking lot (i.e. multiple rows of cars facing north).
- Grades 5-8
 - Dismissal begins at 2:50 p.m.
 - Students will be exiting the same door into which they entered during arrival and meet their family pick up in the Saint Katherine Drexel (SKD) parking lot.
 - Please enter our campus using the main entrance and queue using a modified stadium layout in the SKD parking lot (i.e. multiple rows of cars facing west).



Families with children in more than one K-8 grade will only need to queue once and will collect all their children at the same time beginning with their oldest.

Students not picked up after dismissal and remaining in our building will be sent to After Care. Parents will be responsible for the payments to After Care. No shuttle bus transportation will be provided for the 2022-2023 school year.

Meet the Teacher

All students and families are invited to school on Friday, August 26 (9:00 a.m.-11:30 a.m.). This event is an opportunity to meet the teachers, see the classrooms, and drop off school supplies. We kindly request that families with last names A-L attend 9-10:15 a.m. and families with last names M-Z attend 10:15-11:30 a.m.

First Day of School (Grades 1-8)

Students in grades 1-8 will start school on Monday, August 29. This day is a half-day noon dismissal day, pickup will begin at 11:50 a.m. and no lunch will be served.

First Day of School (PK3, PK4, Kindergarten): Full Day for Grades 1-8

Students in pre-kindergarten 3, pre-kindergarten 4, and kindergarten will start school on Tuesday, August 30. Students will attend according to their enrollment plan (half-day or full-day). Students in grades K-8 will experience their first full day of school on Tuesday, August 30. If your PK3 child has a MWF schedule, then his or her first day will be on Wednesday, August 31.
