

How to Earn your Reading rewards at SFPL in June & July

- **If you have not already**, sign your child up for the 1000 Books Before Kindergarten program at our website: www.spanishfortpubliclibrary.org/1000books, then get your 1000 books information goodie bag at the SFPL front desk.
- Earn one(1) ticket each time you visit SFPL to check out materials or participate in a SR2024 activity from June 1, 2024 - July 27, 2024 .
- You can earn one(1) ticket each time you complete a BINGO (vertical, horizontal, or diagonal). *JULY BINGO sheets will be available upon request at the SFPL front desk 7/1 -7/14/2024*
- Have fun by tracking your reading in JUNE & JULY with the TURTLE TIME TRACKER. For every 20 minutes you spend reading, color in pieces of the turtle in numerical order starting with #1. ***This is a fun summer addition to the 1000 Books trackers you use for the program :)***
- Participate in Summer Reading activities & programs in the library and on the SFPL website to earn more tickets! ***Pre-K Storytime is every THURS @10:00am! And we have programs for ALL ages!***
- Earn a bonus ticket with your BINGO sheets and your Turtle tracker sheet by turning them in at the SFPL front desk the week of 6/24 -29/2024 **or** the week of 7/22 -27/2024.

Reward tickets will not be given for summer reading materials turned in after July 27, 2024.

- Use the tickets you earn to "purchase" SFPL Summer Reading reward items from the Prize Catalog or to "purchase" an entry in the drawing for one SFPL Summer Reading Loot Boxes!*

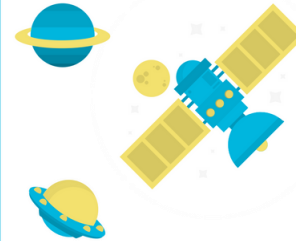

HOW READING CAN HELP CHILDREN



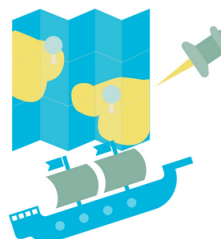
Sitting down with a book provides children with a time for quiet and calmness in their busy lives.
