POSITION TITLE: Information Technology (IT) Systems Technician

RESPONSIBLE TO: Superintendent of Education

REPORTS TO: Information Technology Systems Supervisor

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Extensive knowledge and experience in computer networking (Local and Wide Area Network (LAN/WAN), cabling, and demonstrated skills in computer hardware/software installation, maintenance and repair. Technical certifications such as A+ and Microsoft certifications are preferred.
2. Extensive knowledge of Microsoft operating systems and Microsoft Office applications.
3. Must be able to carry loads of up to 50 pounds and climb extension ladders.
4. Effective skills in human and interpersonal relations and proficiency in written and oral communications.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES/ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Install and configure computer systems for school and/or administrative staff.
